

NOTICE TO APPRENTICES How to apply for WorkBC Apprentice Services

You may be eligible for financial support for the classroom portion of your apprentice training through the WorkBC Apprentice Services. All apprentice services and supports are delivered through the WorkBC Apprentice Services Contractor.

WHO CAN APPLY

You can apply if you are an ITA registered apprentice who meets EI eligibility as an Active EI Claimant receiving EI benefits or has received EI benefits within the last 5 years, and who has an:

- Employer Sponsor, or a
- Union Hiring Hall Sponsor, or an
- Indigenous Skills and Employment Training Program (ISET) Sponsor, or are
- An unemployed pre-existing ITA Registered Apprentice who:
 - Is unemployed and is attached to their Employer Sponsor but does not have a specific return to work date at the time of requesting Financial Supports to attend Classroom Technical Training, or
 - Is unemployed and without an Employer Sponsor, but has an active ITA Apprentice Registration at the time of requesting Financial Supports to attend Classroom Technical Training. (**Note:** The ITA keeps the Apprentice Registration active for 18 months from the date the apprentice loses his/her Employer Sponsor).

HOW TO APPLY

- 1. Apprentices who meet the above criteria <u>MUST</u> apply for WorkBC Apprentice Services Financial Supports through the Online Employment Services (OES) at: http://apply.workbc.ca/; and
- You <u>must apply separately for Employment Insurance (EI) Benefits</u> in their last week of work, or in the
 first week of training to be <u>eligible</u> to receive WorkBC Apprentice Services Financial Supports. EI
 information can be obtained by visiting http://www.servicecanada.gc.ca
 - Already have an Active El Claim? Do not re-apply for El benefits. To ensure there is no
 interruption to your El benefits, you must immediately contact Service Canada and
 provide Service Canada with the 16-digit El Reference Code and start and end dates of
 apprentice training.
- 3. If you do not meet the criteria above under "Who Can Apply", you must contact WorkBC Apprentice Services at 1-844-428-4730 for information on how to apply for financial supports.

<u>Note</u>: To protect and continue to receive your El benefits while in training, Active El claimants who do not need any WorkBC Apprentice Services Financial Supports **MUST** also apply through the Online Employment Services portal at: http://apply.workbc.ca/ to get approval to participate in training.
